### **C.A.T.S. Road Trip**

#### **Old Cahawba Archaeological Park**



The CATS are making a trip September 17, 2018, to the first capitol of Alabama, Cahaba. Cahaba was located at the fork of the Alabama and Cahaba Rivers from 1819 to 1826. Due to flooding, the capital was moved to Tuscaloosa (later to Goat Hill in Montgomery). Cahaba was a cotton farming port town and the cotton warehouses became a military prison during the Civil War.

A forty-passenger bus has been chartered (with a bathroom), to make the trip. The cost is \$50 per person and includes transportation (\$30), meals (\$10), and entrance fee (\$10). We will leave St. Andrew at 7:30 AM and return around 5 PM. A guide will join us on the bus for our tour of the park, so there is little walking. Money needs to be collected by September 9.
