

The museum exhibits memorabilia, artifacts, and military equipment ranging from the American Revolution War to present day. Included in the collection are many rare and important artifacts, including the oldest surviving jeep: the Ford Pygmy. This museum is a true hidden treasure. Come and explore some of our history up-close.
